DISCLAIMER

- a) It is assumed that every participating candidate of NIA-PG Counseling has read, agreed, and accepted the Scheme and terms & conditions of the NIA-PG counseling-2025.
- b) All Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) are mandatory and not optional. Candidates are advised to review compulsorily all Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) before registering on the NIA JAIPUR counseling website (niajaipur.in)
- c) The candidate shall fill out the application form online (niajaipur.in), preferably on their own, for NIA-PG Counseling-2025. Application submitted through any other mode shall be summarily rejected.
- d) While registering on the NIA-PG portal, all candidates are advised to use the same mobile number/e-mail ID they submitted during registration for the AIAPGET-2025 examination.
- e) The candidate should ensure that all the information filled in during the online registration/application form is correct and factual. The data entered by the candidate during registration on the NTA portal for AIAPGET 2025 will be pre-populated, and the same data is used for NIA JAIPUR-counseling purposes. The NIA JAIPUR, NCISM shall not entertain, under any circumstances, any request to change/modify/edit/alter the information provided by the candidates.
- f) Candidates can submit the NIA-PG counseling registration/application form only once. Candidates who submit more than one registration/application form shall be debarred, and further action as deemed appropriate by the NIA JAIPUR shall be taken.
- g) Registration facility shall be available at the beginning of the 1st Round, 2nd Round, 3rd Round & Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I) as specified in the Counseling Schedule. Further, any request (for any reason) for registration shall not be entertained after the closing of registration. **Fresh registration is available during the Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I) for the A.Y. 2025-26.**
- h) The Security Deposit will be forfeited if a candidate who has been allotted a seat in the Second Round or subsequent rounds and does not join the respective institution. The breakdown of the same is as follows-
 - (i) R-2 non-joined/ joined candidates who avail exit with forfeiture.

- (ii) Candidate does not join the allotted seat in the 3rd Round/ Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I & SVR-II)
 - (iii) Candidate does not join the upgraded seat from Round-1, and Round-2 admitted seats.
 - (iv) If the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration based on which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting.
 - (v) Not upgraded candidate of Round-1 resigns from his joined seat after the announcement of the R-2 final result
 - (vi) Candidate resigns his/her joined seat through offline mode after the completion of counseling.
 - (vii) Non-compliance with the NIA-PG counseling scheme 2025.
 - (viii) Candidates withdraw their admitted seats allotted through Round- 2nd/3rd/SVR1SVR- 2.
- i) A candidate, if used a false/fake/incorrect information/document either at the time of registration/during admission, then such candidate shall be excluded from all admission processes and in case, such candidate has already been given admission, the admission shall stand cancelled.
- j) In case, the joined candidates of R-1 whose seats have not been upgraded in R-2 OR joined (allotted/upgraded) candidates of R-2 decided to exit from the institute, in that case:
- i. If they withdraw the seat till 3 days prior to the commencement of 3rd Round, the counseling fee will be forfeited.(**Till 24 October 2025**)
 - ii. If they withdraw the seat between 3 days prior to the commencement of 3rd Round and after that the counseling fee will be forfeited and become ineligible for NIA-PG counseling for the A.Y 2025-26. If any candidate withdraw their seat after **24 October 2025**, then the counseling fee will be forfeited and he/she will be ineligible for further round of NIA DU PG Counseling (For 3rd Round and SVR 1&2) for the A.Y 2025-26.
- k) The reserved vacant (virtual and provisional seat matrix) seats that published before 3rd Round will be converted during the 3rd Round of counseling as per the algorithm placed at Chapter-4 only if the reserved seats are not opted by any candidates/non- availability of candidates of that particular category in the 3rd Round. Further, unreserved category candidates cannot claim the reserved seats shown to them as a virtual vacancy if the candidate of that particular category chooses the same seat.
- l) Once a candidate is allotted a seat in the 3rd Round or Stray Vacancy Round (1st/2nd Allotment), he/she will not be allowed to exit from the admitted/allotted seat. If the Candidate does so, he/she will not be eligible for any NIA-PG counseling and the counseling fees of such candidates will be forfeited
- m) Candidates are advised to visit the College website or contact the College Authorities directly for any query regarding the above information before filling choices. Once

locked, the choices cannot be modified, and any request regarding tinkering choices will not be entertained by NIA JAIPUR.

- n) Candidates are advised to visit the NIA JAIPUR website (niajaipur.in) regularly for updates on Schedule / Results / Notices / Refund of security money etc.
- o) **All admissions will be made through online mode only**; therefore, candidates are advised to ask for an online-generated “**Provisional Admission Letter**” at the time of physical reporting at the allotted institute to ensure that the college has admitted him/her through online mode.
- p) The NIA JAIPUR **will not entertain** the admission/relieving/withdrawal/ cancellation made **through offline mode** by the college under any circumstances. If such action is noticed, it will be considered non-compliance with the NIA JAIPUR-Counseling scheme 2025, and appropriate action shall be taken. Hence, all candidates are advised to ensure their admission/relieving/withdrawal/ cancellation is made **through NIA JAIPUR-Portal only**.
- q) The role of NIA JAIPUR is limited to the allotment of seats to the registered candidates, as per their merit and choices, based on the data/Information of qualified candidates received from the National Testing Agency (NTA), i.e. the AIAPGET-2025 examination conducting body.
- r) The security amount will be refunded to the bank account/credit card from which the payment has been made by the candidates on the NIA-PG portal.
Candidates eligible for refund of the security deposit are strictly advised to keep their bank account/credit card active and functional until they receive the refund.
- s) The NIA JAIPUR reserves its absolute right to alter, amend, modify or apply any or some of the instructions/ guidelines contained in this information bulletin. In case of any ambiguity in interpretation of any of the instructions/ terms/ rules/criteria regarding the determination of eligibility/conduct of counseling/ registration of candidates/ any information contained herein, the interpretation of the NIA JAIPUR shall be final and binding in nature.
- t) **All the In-service candidates selected for MD/MS Program through counseling 2025-26 will not get stipend from National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur. Their parent department/Government will provide the salary to selected In-service candidates.**

RESERVATION POLICY

Reservation Policy of the Central Government for counseling & admission to NIADU is as follows:

- S.C.- 15%
- S.T.- 7.5%

The benefit of reservation will be given only to those castes and tribes that are mentioned in the respective central list of corresponding states published by the Government of India. (Websites: <https://socialjustice.gov.in> and <https://ncst.nic.in>).

- OBC-NCL- 27% (Non-Creamy Layer as per the current updated central list of OBCs <http://www.ncbc.nic.in> ; OBCs present in the state list but not covered in the Central list of OBCs are NOT eligible to claim the reservation under All India Quota. The criteria for the Non-Creamy Layer (OBC-NCL) will be as per the notification of the Government of India).

Candidates belonging to the **Creamy Layer** of OBC are **NOT** entitled to reservation. Such candidates are treated as belonging to the general (GEN), i.e. unreserved category, and they will be eligible only for the OPEN seats – the seats for which all candidates are eligible.

- GEN-EWS- 10% (The benefit of reservation will be given only to those General category candidates who satisfy the conditions prescribed in the prevailing norms and/or notifications issued by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment/Govt. of India.)
- PwBD- 5% (as per relevant Regulations under NCISM/NCH/ITRA Act 2020). Candidates who want to avail of 5% PwBD reservation in AIQ-PG seats of Govt./Govt. Aided/Central/National ASU & H institutions should obtain a Disability Certificate as per 21 Benchmark Disabilities given under RPwD Act 2016 from the designated Disability Centers as per the list enclosed in **ANNEXURE- II**. **The format of the PwBD certificate is attached in Annexure-I. The certificate issued by any other hospital/ board will not be accepted.**

The category of candidates as provided by NTA in the AIAPGET-2025 result database is used for the NIA-PG counseling process.

Candidates must note that the benefit of reservation will be given to them subject to verification of documents. If it is found at any stage that a candidate has used a false / fake / incorrect document, or has furnished false, incorrect or incomplete information, in order to avail the benefit of reservation, then such a candidate shall be excluded from all admission processes. In case such a candidate has already been given admission, the admission shall stand cancelled.

The reserved All India Quota vacant (virtual & Provisional) seats of ASU &H streams under Govt./Govt. Aided/National Institutes/Central Universities that published after the 2nd Round will be converted during the 3rd Round of counseling as per the following centrally approved conversion algorithm, only if the reserved seat is not opted by any candidate/non-availability of candidate of that particular category in 3rd Round. Further, candidates of the unreserved category cannot claim the reserved seats shown to them as a virtual vacancy if the same seat is opted by the candidate of that particular category. The NRI quota seats under Deemed Universities also shall be converted to Management Quota seats during 3rd round, if the Deemed Universities inform their willingness for the same in advance. The said conversion will be done only when the eligible Candidates belonging to the said Conversion Category have exhausted.

ROUND-1

Eligibility:

Only AIAPGET-2025 qualified candidates are eligible to apply/register for the NIA-PG counseling.

Process:

Step 1: Registration for all AIAPGET-2025 qualified candidates who wish to participate in NIA-PG Counseling for admission to NIA DU Counseling seat.

Step 2: Payment of Counseling Fee (Non-Refundable Registration Fee + Refundable Security money) as per the candidate's preference on the „selection of counseling“ in the NIA-PG Portal

Step 3: Choice filling is as per the candidate's preference on streams and Institute. (Candidates can lock their choices as per schedule; if the candidate cannot lock the choices in time, it will automatically be locked as per server time)

Step 4: Processing of Seat allotment as per candidate's merit and choices on streams locked by the candidate/locked as per server time on portal.

Step 5: Publication of provisional result on the NIA-PG portal: If there are any queries on the allotment, candidates must mail to pgcounselling@nia.edu.in within the specified time before publishing the final result. Requests/queries on allotment after publishing the final result shall not be entertained.

Step 6: Publication of final Seat allotment list (final result): Candidates can download the provisional allotment letter from the NIA-PG portal.

Step 7: Physical Reporting to the allotted college/institute with all original documents within the stipulated time as per schedule.

Note: The registration unlocking facility schedule is available “as a one-time measure” for all candidates who have not locked their choices to edit/modify their registration details on the portal if they fill in any wrong information.

ROUND-2

Eligibility for participation:

- a) AIAPGET-2025 qualified candidates who have not registered in Round 1.
- b) Candidates registered and participated in the 1st Round but were not allotted a seat. No need to register again.
- c) R-1 not joined candidates who have opted for free exit in the 1st Round.
- d) Candidates joined the R-1 allotted seat and submitted willingness for up-gradation at the time of reporting during R-1.
- e) Round 1 joined candidates who availed of free exit and filled choices till the last day of choice filling period for R-2 are eligible for seat allotment. (*Free exit period for R-1 joined candidates is available till the date of announcement of the R-2 final result-excluding the R-2 final result date*)

Process:

Step 1: Registration for all AIAPGET-2025 qualified candidates who wish to participate in NIA-PG Counseling for admission MD/MS (Ayu.) (The candidates who participated in 1st Round need not be registered again)

Step 2: Payment of Counseling Fee (Non-Refundable Registration Fee + Refundable Security money) as per the candidate's preference on the „**selection of counseling**“ in the NIA-PG Portal.

(No need to pay by the candidates, who have already paid the counseling fee at the time of registration for 1st Round)

Step 3: Choice filling as per the candidate's preference on streams. **The choices filled during the 1st Round become null & void** (Candidates can lock their choices as per schedule; if the candidate cannot lock the choices in time, it will automatically be locked as per server time)

Step 4: Processing of Seat allotment as per candidate's merit and choices on streams & institutes locked by the candidate/locked as per server time on portal.

Step 5: Publication of provisional result on the NIA-PG portal: If there are any queries on the allotment, candidates must mail to pgcounseling@nia.edu.in within the specified time before publishing the final result. Requests/queries on allotment after publishing the final result shall not be entertained.

Step 6: Publication of final Seat allotment list (final result): Candidates can download the provisional allotment letter from the NIA-PG portal.

Step 7: Physical Reporting to the allotted college/institute with all original documents within the stipulated time as per schedule.

Note: The registration unlocking facility schedule is available “as a one-time measure” for all candidates who have not locked their choices to edit/modify the candidate's registration details on the portal if they fill in any wrong information.

Eligibility for participation:

- a) AIAPGET-2025 qualified candidates who have not registered in Round 1 & Round 2. Need to register afresh.
- b) Candidates who have already registered and complied with the counseling scheme but were not allotted seats in the 1st Round & 2nd Round. No need to register again.
- c) Round 1 allotted candidates who availed of free exit.
- d) Round 1 admitted Candidates who availed of Free Exit till the date of announcement of the R-2 final result (**excluding the final result date**).
- e) Round 1 admitted candidates, but not upgraded during R-2.
- f) Round 1 admitted candidate, but not upgraded during R-2 and availed of exit with forfeiture of counseling fees 3 days prior to the commencement of R-3 can participate in R-3 with full payment of counseling fees.
- g) Candidates joined the R-1 allotted seats and submitted willingness for up-gradation but did not participate in the 2nd Round of counseling.
- h) Candidates joined the Round-2 allotted/upgraded seat and submitted willingness for up-gradation in the 3rd Round.
- i) Round 2 non-joined candidates who availed of exit with forfeiture can participate in R-3 with full payment of counseling fees.
- j) Round 2 joined candidates who availed of exit with forfeiture of counseling fees 3 days prior to the commencement of R-3 can participate in R-3 with full payment of counseling fees.

Process: -

Step 1: Registration for all AIAPGET-2025 qualified candidates who wish to participate in NIA-PG Counseling for admission.

Step 2: Payment of Counseling Fee (Non-Refundable Registration Fee + refundable Security Money) as per candidate's preference on the **selection of counseling** in the NIA-PG Portal. Those candidates who have availed exit with forfeiture of counseling fees need to pay complete counseling fees again for participating in the subsequent rounds.

Step 3: Choice filling as per the candidate's preference on streams and Institute. **The choices filled during the 1st & 2nd Round become null & void** (candidates can lock their choices as per schedule; if the candidate cannot lock the choices in time, it will automatically be locked as per server time)

Step 4: Processing of seat allotment as per candidate's merit and choices on streams and institutes locked by the candidate/locked as per server time on the portal.

Step 5: Publication of provisional result on the NIA-PG portal; if any queries on the allotment, candidates must mail to pgcounselling@nia.edu.in within the specified time before publishing the final result. Requests/queries on allotment after publishing the final result shall not be entertained.

Step 6: Publication of final Seat allotment list (final result): Candidates can download the provisional allotment letter from the NIA-PG portal.

In this regard, it is also informed that the candidates who withdraw their seats during the period after 24 october 2025 are ineligible for NIA-PG Counseling due to non-compliance of NIA-PG Counseling scheme 2025.

Step 7: Physical Reporting to the allotted college/institute with all original documents within the stipulated time as per schedule.

- The remain vacant (not joined/withdrawn) after the 3rd Round of NIA-PG Counseling will continue to be filled through the online Stray Vacancy Round conducted by the NIA JAIPUR.

Eligibility for participation:

- a) Only AIAPGET-2025 qualified candidates who have registered in the 1st/2nd / 3rd Round of NIA-PG counseling are eligible to participate, provided that, -
 - i. Candidates who have not been admitted to any of the seats through NIA-PG counseling or counseling conducted by State/UTs.
- b) Candidates who have not registered in the NIA-PG counseling and have not been admitted to any of the seats through State/UTs counseling are eligible to participate after registration on the NIA-PG Portal.
- c) Round-1 non-joined candidate availed of Free Exit.
- d) Round 1 admitted Candidates who availed of Free Exit till the date of announcement of the R-2 final result (**excluding final result date**).
- e) Round 1 admitted candidates but not upgraded during R-2 and availed of exit with forfeiture 3 days prior to the commencement of R-3 can participate with full payment of counseling fees.
- f) Round 2 non-joined candidates who availed of exit with forfeiture of counseling fees can participate with full payment of counseling fees.
- g) Round 2 admitted/upgraded candidates who availed of exit with forfeiture of counseling fees 3 days prior to the commencement of R-3 can participate with full payment of counseling fees.

Ineligibility for participation:

- a) R-1/R-2 admitted candidates who secured their seats till the date of announcement of the R-3 final result and candidates who have been allotted seats in R-3 are not eligible to participate in the Stray Vacancy Round.
- b) Candidates who withdraw their seats during the period after 24 October 2025 are not eligible to participate in the Stray Vacancy Round.
- c) Candidates who have been admitted through any rounds of Ayush –PG State/UT counseling are ineligible to participate in the Stray Vacancy Round of NIA-PGCounseling.

Salient features of Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I&II) :

Registration & choice filling is available in SVR-I

- a) No up-gradation is available from any of the 3 Rounds to the Stray Vacancy Round.
- b) There will be the **two-phase allotment**: –

Process: -

Step 1: Registration for all AIAPGET-2025 qualified candidates who wish to participate in NIA-PG Counseling for admission in MD/MS (Ayu.). (The candidates who have not been allotted any seats during previous rounds of NIA-PG Counseling need not be registered again)

During registration, Candidates must submit a **willingness in the NIA-PG portal** to participate in the Stray Vacancy Round with an **undertaking** that they are not holding any PG seats allotted through NIA JAIPUR/State/UT-PG counseling and complied the NIA JAIPUR-counseling scheme or counseling conducted by State/UTs. (**Note:** Appropriate disciplinary action shall be taken if the seat is allotted based on the false undertaking given by the candidate on the portal)

Step 2: Payment of Counseling Fee (Non-Refundable Registration Fee + refundable Security Money) as per candidate's preference on the **selection of counseling** in the NIA- s (Candidates eligible for SVR and whose counseling fee has been forfeited due to non-compliance with the counseling scheme need to pay the complete counseling fees again.)

Step 3: Choice filling as per the candidate's preference on streams and Institute. **The choices filled during the 1st/2nd/3rd Round become null & void** (candidates can lock their choices as per schedule; if the candidate cannot lock the choices in time, it will automatically be locked as per server time).

FIRST ALLOTMENT PHASE (SVR-I)

Step 4: Processing the first allotment as per the candidate's merit and choices on streams and institutes locked by the candidate/locked as per server time.

Step 5: Publication of provisional result on the NIA-PG portal; if any queries on the first allotment (SVR-I), candidates can mail to pgcounselling@nia.edu.in within the specified time before publishing the final result. Requests/queries on the first allotment after publishing the final result shall not be entertained.

Step 6: Publication of final SVR-I seat allotment list (final result)

Step 7: Physical reporting to the allotted college/institute with all original documents within the stipulated time (**SVR-I reporting phase**) as per schedule.

SECOND ALLOTMENT PHASE (SVR-II)

Step 1: Publication of vacant seats on the last day of reporting for the SVR-I

Step 2: Processing of the second allotment as per the candidate's merit and choices on streams and institutes locked by the candidate/locked as per server time during the SVR-I

Step 3: Publication of provisional result on the NIA-PG portal; if any queries on the second allotment (SVR-II), candidates can mail to pgcounseling@nia.edu.in within the specified time before publishing the final result. Requests/queries on the second allotment after publishing the final result shall not be entertained.

Step 4: Publication of final SVR-II seat allotment list (final result)

Step 5: Physical Reporting to the allotted college/institute with all original documents within the stipulated time (**SVR-II reporting phase**) as per schedule.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS & FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ"s)

GENERAL GUIDELINES & ROUND-1 (FAQs)

Q.No.1. When will the NIA-PG counseling for this Academic Year start?

Ans: The Online seat allotment process will start as per the Schedule of the NIA-PG Counseling for the Academic Year 2025-26. Please See the Schedule and notices uploaded on the NIA JAIPUR website (niajaipur.in/) from time to time.

Q.No.2. How do I register on the NIA JAIPUR website/Portal, and how do I fill in Choices?

Ans: Candidates must log on to the website (niajaipur.in) to register and fill in choices. Before choice filling/locking for each round, candidates are advised to make a tentative list of colleges or courses as per preference after going through the provisional seat matrix uploaded in the "Current events" section of the NIA JAIPUR website.

IMPORTANT

The registration facility will be available at the beginning of the 1st Round, 2nd Round, 3rd Round and Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I)

Q.No.3. How and when do I have to make the payment for NIA-PG counseling?

Ans: After registration, the payment page appears automatically. Candidates can only make online payments by Net Banking /Credit card/ Debit card (preferably from Nationalised Banks), or UPI. After the successful completion of payment, the candidate can proceed with choice filling.

Q.No.4. Do I have to report to any counseling centre for registration or choice filling?

Ans: No, Online registration and choice filling can be done from a place of convenience (including home) using a laptop/computer with an uninterrupted internet facility.

Q.No.5. Do I need to upload any documents to register on the NIA-PGportal?

Ans: There is no need to upload any academic documents on the portal. However, you need to fill up the similar information which you gave at the time of registration for the AIAPGET-2025 examination on the NTA website.

Q.No.6. How do I get the password for logging in?

Ans: During the process of online registration, you have to create your unique password. Candidates are advised to keep the password confidential till the end of the counseling process. The candidate can change the password as per convenience. Sharing of password can result in its misuse by somebody else, leading to even exclusion of genuine candidates from the online allotment process. *(Please see the password policy uploaded in the NIA JAIPUR portal)*

Q.No.7. Difficulty in login; what may be the problem(s)?

Ans: Follow the instructions about the use of the browser (latest registered version of Chrome/Internet Explorer/Firefox/Windows/IOS), as it is difficult to log in from other browsers. Use similar spellings and the similar format of the date as in the online application form submitted at the time of registration of the AIAPGET-2025 examination on the NTA website. The internet connection should be uninterrupted. If an interruption in the internet connection occurs, the IP address being monitored will change, and the session expired message will be displayed.

Q.No.8. I have difficulty in creating a Password; what may be the problem(s)?

Ans: Create a password as per the password policy uploaded on the website. Please use the internet browser as suggested above (Q.No.7) while creating a password. Use the “Shift” key instead of the „Caps Lock“ key.

Q.No.9. If I forgot the password, how to retrieve it?

Ans: To retrieve the forgotten password, the software system facilitates the following process:

Reset password using a reset link via registered E-mail

Candidate has to enter their AIAPGET-2025 examination Roll No. If entered data (Roll No.) matches with the backend database, then the system will send a reset password link to the registered email-id. After clicking the received link in the mail-inbox, candidates must follow the online instructions to reset the New Password.

OR

Reset password using an OTP via SMS

Candidate has to enter their AIAPGET-2025 examination Roll No. If entered data (Roll No.) matches with the backend database, then the system will send a verification code through SMS to the registered mobile no. Candidates are required to enter a verification code, and if the verification code matches with the database, the system will prompt resetting New Password.

Q.No.10. Is filling up and locking of choices necessary to get the seat allotted? Or will I be allotted a seat automatically from leftover seats?

Ans: After online registration, you must fill in the choices of courses in order of your preference (higher to lower) and lock it before the server time during each round of counseling as per schedule. The submitted/ filled choices can be modified before locking. If candidates do not lock the choices submitted by them, it will automatically be locked as per schedule/ Server time. You will not be allotted any seats if you don't fill in choices even after registering on the NIA JAIPUR portal. Candidates can download/print out the locked choices for future reference.

Q.No.11. Is it necessary to download the duly filled registration form for NIA-PG Counseling from the NIA JAIPUR- portal?

Ans: Yes, it is necessary to download the duly filled registration form for NIA-PG Counseling from the NIA-PG portal. Some universities instruct the candidates to submit the same to complete the admission process.

Q.No.12. Can I modify my choices during the choice submission period for counseling?

Ans: Yes, you can modify, add or delete your choices during the choice Filling period. Further, it is advised to do the same before locking the choices by yourself or the System as per schedule/ Server time.

Q.No.13. What will happen to my choices if I have not locked my choices before the time specified in the counseling schedule on the last date of choice locking?

Ans: The choices submitted and saved will be locked automatically on the last date of choice filling/locking period as per server time.

Q.No.14. How can I get a printout of my choices?

Ans: Candidates are requested to login to the NIA-PG portal and take a printout of their choices that they have locked during the choice filling /Locking period or after the specified time of the last date of choice locking.

Q.No.15. Is it possible to modify/edit my choices after the choice locking?

Ans: Once the choices are locked, it is impossible to unlock the same, even from the NIA JAIPUR end. Hence, the candidates are advised to verify all choices before locking in. The Choices, once locked, cannot be modified, and any request to the NIA JAIPUR, regarding tinkering of choices will not be entertained.

Q.No.16. What about the Stipend/ fee structure/ bond amount / accommodation / hostel/ food/ rendering of service in rural/ tribal areas/other conditions for the allotted course/college?

Ans: Information is available on college website.

Q.No.17. How much time will be given to join the allotted course/Institute?

Ans: see counseling schedule

Q.No.18. Whether my admission is valid if the college admitted me to the allotted seat through offline mode?

Ans: No, the NIA JAIPUR will not approve the admission made through offline mode by the college under any circumstances. Therefore, candidates are advised to ask for an online generated **Provisional Admission Letter** through the NIA-PG portal at the time of admission to ensure that the college has admitted him/her through online mode.

Q.No.19. What documents are required at the time of joining in allotted ASU&H College?

Ans: Original documents (along with attested photocopies, preferably 02 sets of documents) required at the time of joining the allotted College are as mentioned below:

- i. **Provisional Allotment Letter** issued by NIA JAIPUR
- ii. **AIAPGET-2025 Admit Card** issued by NTA
- iii. **AIAPGET-2025 Score Card** issued by NTA
- iv. **Class 10th Pass Certificate and Marks sheet**
- v. **Higher Secondary Certificate and Marks sheet**
- vi. **Mark Sheets of BAMS** 1st, 2nd & 3rd Professional Examinations or 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th Professional Examinations (as applicable).
- vii. **BAMS Degree Certificate or Provisional Degree Certificate (MQRL-Under Graduate -Medical Qualification should be duly recognized by NCISM).**
- viii. **Twelve months Compulsory Rotatory Internship Completion Certificate.**
- ix. **Permanent Registration Certificate at time of course commencement.**
- x. **Permanent Registration Certificate** issued by NCISM/State Ayurveda Board
- xi. **Date of Birth Certificate.** [If the 10th Certificate does not bear the same.]
- xii. **Eight (8) Passport size photographs.** (Same as affixed on the AIAPGET-2025/NIA-PGcounseling-2025 online application form).
- xiii. Candidates must carry one of the **identification proofs** (ID Proof) to the allotted college at the time of admission (i.e. PAN Card, Driving License, Voter ID, Passport or Aadhar Card).

xiv. **Medical Fitness Certificate** issued by Registered Medical Practitioner in the prescribed format is attached as (**Annexure-VI**).

xv. **Transfer Certificate/College Leaving Certificate** from the last studied institution.

xvi. The Candidate should also bring the following certificate, if applicable:

- a) **Disability Certificate** issued from a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board for 21 Benchmark Disabilities as per the Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016, will be accepted. The format of the Certificate of Disability is attached as (**Annexure-I**). No other PwD certificate issued by any other Authorities/ Hospital will be accepted. (The qualified candidates with Benchmark Disability (PwBD)-should get themselves certified at one of the Disability Assessment Boards, constituted in various States/UTs. The list of authorized designated Centers that will issue Disability Certificates as per 21 Benchmark Disabilities given under RPwD Act-2016 is attached as (**Annexure-II**).
- b) **SC/ST Certificate issued by the competent authority**, and it should be either in English or Hindi. Sub-caste should be mentioned in the certificate and tally with the respective central list of corresponding states published by the Government of India (<https://socialjustice.gov.in/common/76750>) and (https://tribal.nic.in/Knowledge_Hub.aspx).
The certificate should be **as per the prescribed format** of the Government of India (**Annexure -III**).
- c) **OBC-NCL certificate** issued by the Competent Authority (**issued on or after 1 April 2025**) **as per the prescribed format** of the Government of India. The sub-caste in the OBC-NCL certificate should tally with the updated Central List of OBC <http://www.ncbc.nic.in>. The OBC-NCL certificate format is attached as (**Annexure-IV**).
- d) **Economically Weaker Section (GEN-EWS) certificate** issued **on or after 1 April 2025** by the Competent Authority. (**Annexure-V**)

Q.No.20. I joined the BAMS course before 2010 and graduated with 6 months internship, am I eligible to participate in the NIA-PGcounseling?

Ans. Yes. The candidates who joined BAMS courses before 2010 and graduated with 6 months'' internship are eligible to participate in the NIA-PGcounseling. (Refer: CCIM Regulations 1989)

Q.No.21. In which format should I submit the certificates; if I do not submit certificates in the prescribed format, what will happen to my allotted seat?

OR

What are the instructions regarding GEN-EWS, OBC, SC, ST & PwBD certificates and Reservations?

Ans. Candidates need to submit the relevant certificates issued by the competent authority in the prescribed format of the Government of India, as mentioned in annexures. If the candidate fails to produce the Caste, EWS and PwBD certificate in the prescribed format at the allotted ASU & H College, then he/she will not be permitted to take admission.

Q.No.22. From where will I get the details of the reservation and certificates?

Ans. You must read the AIAPGET-2025 Bulletin/Prospectus carefully regarding Caste, GEN-EWS and PwBD Reservation/Certificate. Please click on the link to see the AIAPGET-2025 Information Bulletin.

Q.No.23. Is there any upper age limit for the candidates seeking admission to ASU &H-PG courses for the academic year 2025-26?

Ans: There is no upper age limit for admission to ASU & H-PG courses.

Q.No.24. If I have a Birth Certificate/Caste Certificate/other certificates (s) in the regional language, will it be acceptable at the time of reporting/joining?

Ans: Certificates issued by the Competent Authority shall preferably be in Hindi or English language. In case the certificate is issued in regional language (other than Hindi or English), candidates are advised to carry a certified (attested) Copy of the Hindi/English version of the original certificate along with the original certificate.

Q.No.25. What can I do if there is a spelling discrepancy between the documents and the application form?

Ans: If there is a discrepancy in spelling in documents, the candidate must carry an affidavit/undertaking to prove that the documents belong to the same person.

Q.No.26. At the time of admission, will my original certificates be retained by the allotted college/institution?

Ans: **Yes**, NIA Jaipur will retain the original certificates of admitted students and release

them only after the seat has been upgraded or the candidate withdraws/cancels the seat.

Q.No.27. Whether candidate's category will be changed during admission at the allotted institute if a category candidate (OBC-NCL/EWS...etc.) gets allotted a seat under the UR category?

Ans: No, if the candidate has a valid category certificate (OBC-NCL/EWS...etc.), the candidate's category (OBC-NCL/EWS...etc.) will not be changed to the allotted UR category during admission at the allotted institute. But, if the candidate fails to produce a valid category certificate (OBC-NCL/EWS...etc.), the college has to change the candidate's category to the allotted category on the portal while verifying documents after getting consent from the candidate for completing the admission process.

Q.No.28. What happens if the college/institute changes the category (e.g. OBC-NCL/EWS) of the candidate to the allotted category (UR) during admission if the candidate gets allotted a UR category seat?

Ans. Suppose the college changes the candidate's category (e.g. OBC-NCL/EWS) to the allotted UR category on the portal during admission for any reason; in that case, the candidate will be considered as a UR candidate in subsequent rounds of counseling, and they are not eligible for allotment of the seat of their category (e.g. OBC-NCL/EWS). Hence, candidates are advised to be aware of this category change during choice filling for the subsequent rounds.

Q.No.29. I have registered in the 1st Round; should I register again for the 2nd Round?

Ans: Only candidates who have not registered in the 1st Round need to register afresh for the 2nd Round.

Q.No.30. I have submitted willingness for up-gradation in the 2nd Round while joining the 1st Round allotted seat. Later changed my decision and wanted to retain the 1st Round joined seat; how it is possible?

Ans: The candidate does not need to fill any fresh choices for the 2nd Round, so the earlier R-1 joined seat will be retained. If the seat gets upgraded on submission of fresh choices during R-2, the earlier R-1 joined seat will be cancelled. Further, the candidate needs to join the Round-2 upgraded seat as per the R-2 reporting rules of Counseling Scheme 2025.

Q.No.31. Is it necessary to join the allotted ASU&H College of Round-1 to get a chance to participate in the 2nd Round?

Ans: No. If the candidate is not interested in the 1st Round allotted seat, he/she can avail free exit without reporting/joining the allotted college; further, he/she can participate in the 2nd Round with fresh choices. However, if he/she wants to hold the Round-1 allotted seat, he/she should join the allotted College physically and submit willingness for up-gradation

for the 2nd Round.

Q.No.32. Who is eligible for the 2nd Round of allotment?

Ans: Candidates eligible for seat allotment in the 2nd Round would be from one of the following groups:

Group-I: Newly registered candidate for R-2

Group-II: Registered candidates who got no seats in the R-1.

Group-III: Candidates who have reported at the R-1 allotted institute and submitted willingness for 2nd Round up-gradation.

Group-IV: Candidates who have been allotted seats in the 1st Round but availed of „free exit“.

Group-V: Candidates who have resigned/availed free exit from the R-1 joined seats before the commencement of R-2 and filled choices till the last day of the choice-filling period for R-2.

Q.No.33. What is the procedure for 2nd Round?

Ans: All eligible candidates who wish to participate in the 2nd Round of online allotment will have to submit fresh choices and lock the choices during the choice-filling/locking period. All choices will be published as provisional and virtual seat matrices on the portal. The virtual vacancies are seats likely to be get vacated during up-gradation. Eligible candidates will be allotted seats based on their merit and choices.

Choices submitted during R-1 will become null and void. In the case of candidates who have submitted willingness for up-gradation in R-2, their remaining choices submitted during R1 would be initialized (i.e., the choices remaining after allotment of seats in Round-1 will stand cancelled); hence, **all candidates are required to submit fresh choices for up-gradation to the 2nd Round.**

Q.No.34. Do I have to fill up the choice of courses and Colleges to participate in the 2nd Round of the online allotment process?

Ans: Yes, eligible candidates must submit fresh choice(s) of course(s) for online seat allotment during the 2nd Round. In case a candidate does not fill in fresh choice(s) during the choice-filling period, the candidate will not be considered for seat allotment during the 2nd Round and will retain the already joined seat in the 1st Round, if any.

Q.No.35. Is it necessary to join the R-2 allotted college/seat that upgraded from R-1?

Ans: Yes. If the candidate gets upgraded a seat during R-2, the R-1 joined seat **will be cancelled automatically (i.e., that seat will be allotted to somebody else). Upgraded candidates of R-2 are advised to** join the college/seat as per the reporting rules after obtaining an online-generated relieving letter from the R-1 joined college. If R-1 joined candidates upgraded in R-2 and do not wish to join the upgraded college/seat, they can avail of exit with forfeiture of counseling fees.

Seats can also be upgraded in the same college (same course) by change of category (i.e.ST/SC/OBC to UR or PwD to non-PwD) during R-2; in such a case, the candidate has to take fresh admission on the upgraded seat of R-2 by taking online generated „***Relieving letter***“ from the R-1 Joined seat.

Q.No.36. Is it necessary to join the R-2 allotted college/seat?

Ans: If candidates get allotted a seat in R-2 and wish to join, they are advised to join the allotted seat as per schedule, otherwise, they can avail of exit with forfeiture of counseling fees.

Q.No.37. What is the time period for the free exit for R-1 admitted candidates?

Ans: R-1 admitted candidates who wish to resign the R-1 seat can avail of free exit till the date of announcement of the R-2 final result. After this stipulated time, R-1 joined candidates are treated as R-2 joined candidates, and R-2 rules will apply to them.

Q.No.38. If my R-1 seat is not upgraded in R-2, and I wish to withdraw R-1 joined seat, will I be eligible to participate in further rounds of NIA-PG Counseling?

Ans: After the announcement of the R-2 result, R-1 joined candidates who have not been upgraded in Round 2 are treated as R-2 joined candidates, **and R-2 rules apply to them.** If such candidates wish to withdraw their R-1 joined seat, they can exit with forfeiture of counseling fees till three days prior to the commencement of R-3, then they will be eligible to participate in NIA JAIPUR counseling. If the candidate withdraws the seat beyond the stipulated period, he will be ineligible for NIA-PG Counseling.

Q.No.39. I opted for up-gradation in the 2nd Round/3rd Round of counseling when reporting to the 1st Round/2nd Round allotted seat. Will my earlier joined R-1/R-2 seat be cancelled?

Ans: Yes, once the seat is upgraded during the 2nd Round/ 3rd Round, the earlier R-1/R-2 joined seat will automatically be cancelled, respectively, and the same will be allotted to another candidate. Therefore, you are advised to fill in only higher choices or choices which you prefer over the earlier joined seat.

Q.No.40. Can I join the college directly if my seat gets upgraded during the 2nd Round/3rd Round from the 1st Round/2nd Round of NIA-PG counseling?

Ans: No, You must get an online-generated relieving letter from the earlier R-1/R-2 joined institute/college before joining the R-2/R-3 upgraded seat/college. The candidate will not be permitted to join the upgraded seats without a relieving letter from earlier admitted institutes and original documents

Q.No.41. If I get an upgraded seat in the same college because of a change of category (e.g. from SC/ST/OBC to UR category), do I have to take admission on the upgraded seat again?

Ans: Yes, you have to proceed as follows:

Step-1: Get an **online-generated relieving letter** through the NIA JAIPUR portal from the institute for the earlier joined seat.

Step-2: You must join the upgraded category seat and get an online-generated **Provisional Admission Letter** through the NIA JAIPUR portal for the upgraded category seat (your earlier joined seat would be cancelled and allotted to another candidate).

Q.No.42. Is it necessary to join the 2nd Round allotted/upgraded seat to participate in the 3rd Round?

Ans: If a candidate gets allotted/ upgraded a seat in R-2, following rules he must follow to participate in 3rd Round:

- If a candidate wishes to hold the R-2 allotted/upgraded seat, he/she needs to join the college physically and give up-gradation willingness for the 3rd Round at the time of admission to the 2nd Round allotted/upgraded college.
- If a candidate does not wish to hold the R-2 allotted/upgraded seat, he can avail of exit with forfeiture of counseling fees as per the reporting schedule for R-2 (need to pay complete fees again to participate in subsequent rounds as per the eligibility criteria fixed for that round.)
- If a candidate wants to resign the Round-2 joined seat, can withdraw the seat 3 days prior to the commencement of the 3rd Round with forfeiture of counseling fees; then he/she will be eligible to participate in further NIA JAIPUR PG counseling. If a candidate fails to do so, he/she shall become ineligible for NIA-PG counseling.

Q.No.43. If I joined the Round-2 allotted seat but later changed my decision and wanted to exit, can I participate in further counseling?

Ans: Conditions to participate in further counseling is as follows:

- Round-2 joined candidates who withdraw/surrender their seats three days prior the commencement of the 3rd Round with forfeiture of counseling fees can participate in further NIA JAIPUR PG counseling.
- R-2 joined candidates who withdraw their admitted seat with forfeiture of counseling fees after 24 October 2025 **ineligible** for further rounds of NIA-PG Counseling.
- R-2 joined candidates who withdraw their admitted seat with forfeiture of counseling fees from the date of announcement of R-3 final result will become **ineligible** for NIA JAIPUR/State-UT-PG Counseling.

Q.No.44. Is there a free exit available in Round 2?

Ans: There is no free exit available in R-2. Candidates who get allotted/ upgraded a seat in R-2 are advised to join the R-2 allotted/upgraded seat as per the reporting schedule.

Otherwise, their counseling fees will be forfeited.

Q.No.45. Am I eligible for further PG counseling if I resign from joined course allotted in the 2nd Round?

Ans: Yes. Candidate shall be eligible for further NIA JAIPUR -PG counseling if he/she withdraws the R-2 joined institute/ course three days prior to the commencement of registration for the 3rd Round with forfeiture of counseling fees.

Q.No.46. Who will be eligible for the “Exit with Forfeiture” option in the 2nd Round?

Ans: Following candidates will be eligible for Exit with Forfeiture“

- Candidates who do not wish to join the R-2 allotted seat can avail of exit with forfeiture within the reporting schedule as per the NIA-PG counseling scheme.
- Candidates who wish to withdraw the R-2 joined seat can avail of exit with forfeiture three days before the commencement of the 3rd Round so that he/she will be eligible for NIA JAIPUR -PG counseling. If the candidate fails to do so within the stipulated period, he/she will be **ineligible**.
- R-1 joined candidates whose seat has not been upgraded in R-2 can avail of exit with forfeiture three days before the commencement of the 3rd Round so that he/she will be eligible for NIA JAIPUR -PG counseling. If the candidate fails to do so within the stipulated period, he/she will be **ineligible**.

Q.No.47. If I withdraw the R-1/R-2 joined seat on or after the announcement of the R-3 final result, will I be eligible for PG counseling?

Ans: No. If the candidates withdraw the R-1/R-2 joined seats on or after the announcement of the R-3 final result with forfeiture of counseling fees, they will be **ineligible for NIA JAIPUR counseling**

ROUND-3 (FAQs)

IMPORTANT

Candidates are advised to take a calculated decision to participate in 3rd round as they would not be permitted to resign from 3rd round allotted seat. They will also not be allowed to participate in PG Counseling for this year once a seat is allotted in 3rd round.

Q.No.48. I have registered in the 1st and 2nd Round; should I register again for the 3rd Round?

Ans: Only candidates who have not registered in the 1st Round and 2nd Round need to register afresh for the 3rd Round. Further, candidates who avail of exit with forfeiture of counseling fees need to pay complete fees again to participate in the 3rd Round as per the eligibility criteria for R-3.

Q.No.49. Who will be eligible for the 3rd Round of NIA-PG Counseling?

Ans: The following categories of candidates are eligible for the 3rd Round:

Group I: Candidates who are registering for the first time.

Group II: Registered candidates who have not been allotted seats in Round 1 & 2.

Group III: Round 1 allotted candidate who availed of free exit.

Group IV: Round 1 joined candidates who opted for up-gradation but did not participate in the 2nd Round of counseling (with fresh choice filling).

Group V: Round 1 joined candidates who availed of free exit till the date of announcement of the R-2 final result (**excluding final result date**) and did not participate in the 2nd Round.

Group VI: Round 1 joined candidates but not upgraded during R-2.

Group VII: Round 1 admitted candidates but not upgraded during R-2 and availed of exit with forfeiture of counseling fees 3 days prior to the commencement of R-3 can participate with full payment of counseling fees.

Group VIII: Round 2 allotted/upgraded candidates who avail of exit with forfeiture can participate with full payment of counseling fees.

Group IX: Round 2 joined candidates who submitted willingness for up gradation at the time of reporting to the R-2 allotted institute.

Group X: Round 2 joined candidates who avail of exit with forfeiture of counseling fees 3 days prior to the commencement of R-3 can participate with full payment of counseling fees.

Q.No.50. What is the procedure for the 3rd Round of Counseling?

Ans: Eligible candidates may submit fresh Choices during the 3rd Round choice filling period and will be allotted seats based on merit and choices locked by the candidate/as per server time.

The provisional and virtual seat matrix for vacant seats will be published on the NIA JAIPUR portal. Candidates will be shown all available choices against actual and virtual vacancies. (Virtual vacancies are likely to be available when the seats get vacated during up-gradation and the seat conversion as per the following algorithm).

The reserved vacant seats published before 3rd Round will be converted during the 3rd Round of counseling as per the following algorithm, only if the reserved seat is not opted by any candidate/non-availability of candidate of that particular category in 3rd Round.

IMPORTANT

During 3rd Round, conversion algorithm will be applied on those reserved category seats which are not opted by any candidate (or may be due to non-availability of candidate of that particular category) and such converted seats are exhibited as virtual vacancies during choice filling for Round-3 on the portal. Candidates cannot claim for such virtual vacancies because such seats will be allotted to them only if the same seats are not opted by the candidate of the reserved category.

Q.No.51. Is the Up-gradation allowed from the 1st /2nd Round to the 3rd Round of the NIA-PG counseling?

Ans: Yes. Up-gradation is allowed from the 1st /2nd Round to the 3rd Round of NIA JAIPUR counseling for the candidates who submitted willingness for upgradation at the time of reporting to the R-1/R-2 allotted institute. However, the candidates must join the R-3 allotted seat that upgraded from 1st & 2nd Round admitted seats as their earlier joined R-1/R-2 seat stands cancelled. If such candidates do not join the upgraded seats in Round-3, their counseling fees will be forfeited, and they will become ineligible for further -PG counseling.

Q.No.52. What will happen if a candidate does not join the 3rd Round allotted/upgraded seat?

Ans: If a candidate does not join the 3rd Round allotted/upgraded seat as per schedule, the candidate's admission will be cancelled with forfeiture of counseling fees. Further, he/she will become ineligible for any other further round of counseling.

Q.No.53. I joined the R-1 allotted seat and submitted my willingness to upgrade the seat; for some reason, I could not participate in the 2nd Round. Will I be eligible to participate in R-3?

OR

I joined the R-1 allotted seat but was not upgraded during R-2. Will I be eligible to participate in R-3?

Ans: Yes. You are eligible to participate in R-3 of NIA-PG Counseling as per the eligibility criteria fixed for Round 3.

Q.No.54. What will happen to vacant seats after the completion of the 3rd Round?

Ans: All seats that remain vacant after the completion of the 3rd Round will continue to be allotted during the online Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I & SVR-II) conducted by the NIA JAIPUR.

Q. No.55. How does NIA JAIPUR prohibit ineligible candidates from Participating in further -PG Counseling?

Ans:

- **Ineligibility for NIA-PG Counseling**

Candidates who withdrew their seats after 24 October 2024 or did not comply with the NIA-PG counseling scheme 2025 the date of announcement of the R-3 final result are

ineligible to participate in NIA-PG counseling, which means the NIA JAIPUR PG portal will block the candidature of the applicant from participating in further rounds of NIA-PG Counseling.

- **Ineligibility for NIA JAIPUR -PG Counseling**

Candidates who secured their PG seats through R-1/R-2 till the date of announcement of the R-3 final result or who have been allotted seats in R-3/SVR-I/SVR-II or who did not comply with the NIA-PG Counseling scheme and withdraw their seats beyond the period mentioned for each round as per the counseling scheme are ineligible to participate in NIA JAIPUR -PG Counseling.

Q.No.57: Is registration available in the Stray vacancy round of NIA-PGcounseling?

Ans: Yes. Fresh registration is **available** in the Stray vacancy round (SVR-I) of NIA JAIPUR- PG counseling. Candidates who wish to participate in the Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I & II)- for Govt./ Govt. Aided/CU/NI/Deemed Universities are advised to register during SVR- I as per eligibility criteria fixed for SVR.

Q.No.58. Is choice filling available in the Stray vacancy round of NIA-PGcounseling?

Ans: Yes. The choice filling is **available** in the Stray vacancy round (SVR-I) of NIA JAIPUR- PG counseling for allotment of seats, however, the choice filling is **not available** during SVR-II of NIA JAIPUR- PG counseling.

Q.No.59. Should I submit any willingness to participate in the SVR for (SVR-I & II)?

Ans. To participate in the Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I & II), candidates must submit willingness cum undertaking on the NIA-PG portal that they are not holding any PG seats allotted through any rounds of NIA-PG counseling/State-UTs Counseling.

Q.No.60. Is any Up-gradation allowed from the 1st/2nd/3rd Round to the Stray Vacancy Round of the NIA-PGcounseling?

Ans: No. Up-gradation is not allowed from the 1st/2nd/3rd Round to the Stray Vacancy Round of the NIA-PGcounseling.

Q.No.61. Is any Up-gradation allowed from SVR-I to SVR-II of the NIA- PG counseling?

Ans: No. Up-gradation is not allowed from SVR-I to SVR-II of the NIA-PG counseling.

Q.No.62. Who is Eligible for the Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I & II)?

Ans. Group I: Candidates who are registering for the first time. (Need to register afresh on the portal during SVR-I)

Group II: Registered candidates who do not hold any seats through previous rounds of NIA-PG Counseling or State/UTs counseling.

Group III: Round 1 non-joined candidate availed of Free Exit.

Group IV: Round 1 allotted candidate availed of free exit but did not participate in R-2/ R-3 of NIA-PG Counseling.

Group V: Round 1 joined Candidates who availed of Free Exit till the date of announcement of the R-2 final result (**excluding the final result date**).

Group VI: Round 1 joined candidates not upgraded during R-2 who availed of exit with forfeiture 3 days prior to the commencement of R-3 and not registered in R-3 can register afresh with full payment of counseling fees to participate in SVR.

Group VII: Round 2 non-joined candidates who availed of exit with forfeiture and not registered in R-3 can register afresh with full payment of counseling fees to participate in SVR.

Group VIII: Round 2 joined candidates who availed of exit with forfeiture 3 days prior to the commencement of R-3 and not registered in R-3 can register afresh with full payment of counseling fees to participate in SVR.

IMPORTANT

*There will be data sharing between State and Centre and if any candidate has its name in the list of **admitted** candidates (State/Central lists), then such candidates shall be ineligible for NIAPG- Stray Vacancy Round.*

Q.No.63. Who is ineligible for the Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I & II) for NIA?

Ans:

Group I: Candidates who have been admitted through any previous rounds of NIA-PG Counseling and State/UT counseling or AACCC.

Group II: R-1/R-2 admitted candidates who secured their AIQ-PG seats till the date of announcement of the R-3 final result.

Group III: Candidates who have been allotted seats in R-3

Group IV: Candidates who did not comply with the NIA-PG Counseling scheme 2025.

Further, candidates who have been allotted seats in SVR-I will not be considered for seat allotment during SVR-II.

Q.No.64. What will happen if I do not join the seat allotted through the Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I /SVR-II) of the NIA-PG counseling?

Ans: Candidate must join the seat allotted through the Stray Vacancy Round (**SVR-I/SVR-II**), otherwise, the admission will be cancelled and become ineligible for counseling with forfeiture of counseling fees.

Q.No.65. What will happen if I withdraw the joined seat of SVR?

Ans: If a candidate withdraws the joined seat of SVR,

- i) Counseling fees will be forfeited
- ii) Ineligible for further -PG Counseling

Q.No.66. Should the Security money be refunded if a candidate is not allotted a seat through any round of NIA-PG counseling?

Ans: Yes. If the candidate is not allotted any seat during NIA-PG counseling, the security money will be refunded to the bank account/credit card provided by the candidate at the time of registration on the portal.

Note:- Candidate eligible for refund of security money are strictly advised to keep their bank account/credit card active/ functional till they received the refund.
